Counting a variety of resources and toys throughout the day.

Providing a variety of role play and dressing up

Activities around topics, cultures, celebrations and communities.

Lots of outdoor play including exploring the natural world both in our nursery garden and the wider community.

Wide variety of play including, sand, water, construction, vehicles, building, small world, home corner etc

Expressive Arts and Design

Wide range if messy play and tools available each day.

Variety of mark making tools and resources easy to access.

Exploring messy play, art and design indoors and outdoors. Opportunities for big group art as well individual.

Children encouraged to explore different materials and colours.

Practitioners model the sue of different materials to create sounds. Singing.
