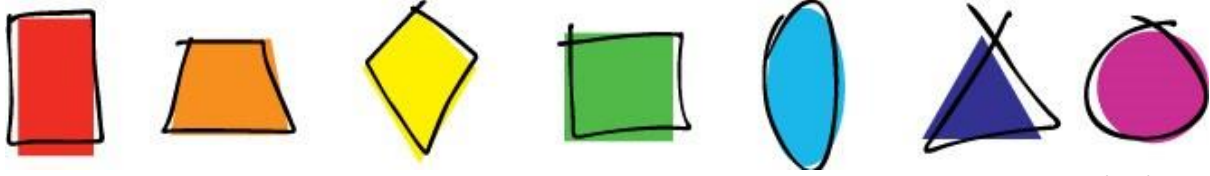


# little rainbows

Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly, I would like to thank everyone who has got back in touch with us since sending out our questionnaire last week.

After looking at the numbers of children and staffing we have decided that we will continue with present pattern of opening for the rest of June.

**From the 15<sup>th</sup> June to the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July we will be open as follows:**

**Tuesday 7am to 6pm**

**Wednesday 7am to 4pm**

**Thursday 7am to 6pm**

**Friday 7am to 6pm.**

**Moving forward our aim is that from the week beginning the 6<sup>th</sup> of July we will re-open full time (Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm)**

At this point staff will be working part time spreading out the hours to allow all the children to have some time with their key workers.

At present the government have specified several conditions which we have to follow: the first being that we must create bubbles of children. The current numbers of children mean's that those attending create our bubble therefore should anyone within the bubble (staff or child) test positive for COVID-19 then we will have to close nursery for the 14 day isolation period.

The government have also stated that at present we are **not allowed to run our Out of School Club**. At present we do not know how long this will be the case for.

Should we find that our numbers are increasing to a point where we have too many children for one bubble. We look to use our Out of School Club to create a second bubble for our pre-school children.
