Dear Parents/Carers,

Following on from the latest developments and the governments new latest announcements. We are writing to update you on some new measures that we are putting into place within nursery.

Drop off and collection

We would like to remind parents of the importance of social distancing at drop off/collection times.

We ask that where possible you use a face mask and wait outside.

We appreciate that this is difficult especially during the winter however; failing to do so could result in parents, staff and children having to self-isolate for 10 days.

The following guidance is set out by the government for identifying close contact, for the purpose of identifying those who will need to self -isolate.

- anyone who has had any of the following types of contact with someone who has tested
 positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) with a PCR test up to 2 days prior to that person showing
 symptoms:
 - face-to-face contact including being coughed on or having a face-to-face conversation within 1 metre skin-to-skin physical contact for any length of time
 - been within 1 metre for 1 minute or longer without face-to-face contact
 - been within 2 metres of someone for more than 15 minutes (either as a one-off contact or added up together over 1 day)

Nursery

- On arrival parents are asked to ensure they have everything ready to hand over and have said goodbye to their child/children before ringing the doorbell.
 You will see a new baby gate inside nursery at the end of the coat pegs, this is so that staff can ensure that only the child being collected/drop off is in that area at that time and can help them to get ready to go home.
- On collection staff will bring your child to the coat peg area where they will collect all belongings and help children to put their coat's etc on before opening the door.
- Should you need to speak to a member of staff and you anticipate it to take more than a
 minute we ask that you either send us a message via Famly or ring nursery on 01924 235264
 to speak to a member of staff directly.
- If a member of staff needs to pass on information that will take more than a minute to do, they
 will attempt to contact parents/carer during the day either via telephone or a direct message
 through Famly.

Out of School Club

 On arrival parents are asked to ensure they have everything ready to hand over and have said goodbye to their child/children before ringing the doorbell.

- On collection staff will ask your child/children to get ready to leave and collect all belongings before opening the door.
- Should you need to speak to a member of staff and you anticipate it to take more than a
 minute we ask that you either send us a message via Famly or ring nursery on 01924 235264
 to speak to a member of staff directly.
- If a member of staff needs to pass on information that will take more than a minute to do, they will attempt to contact parents/carer during the day either via telephone or a direct message through Famly.
